American Health Policy Institute Appoints Henry C. Eickelberg Senior Fellow

Former PBGC Advisor, ERISA Expert and Award-Winning Adjunct Professor at Georgetown Law, Eickelberg Brings Decades of Experience in Health Care Policy

Washington, D.C. – Today, the American Health Policy Institute (AHPI) announces the appointment of Henry C. Eickelberg, a recognized expert in health care and retirement policy, as a Senior Fellow. Mr. Eickelberg will provide expertise to the Institute on key health care policy issues of interest to large employers and will recommend policy solutions to promote high-quality, value-driven, and affordable employer-sponsored health insurance.

Tevi Troy, CEO of AHPI, said, “With Henry’s vast knowledge of the law and experience shaping large employer health plans, he will provide extremely helpful practice-oriented insight to the Institute’s research. We are excited to have him join the Institute and our team of experts.”

Mr. Eickelberg is an adjunct professor of law Georgetown University Law Center where he serves as the faculty advisor for the employee benefit certificate program. He is a recipient of the 2014/2015 Charles Fahy Distinguished Adjunct Faculty Award.

He was appointed in May 2016 by President Obama to serve on the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation (PBGC) Advisory Committee as a representative of business interests. The committee provides input to the PBGC on its administrative and strategic direction. He is also the employer co-chair for one of the nation’s largest multiemployer pension and 401(k) funds.

Mr. Eickelberg was previously the Vice President of Human Resources and Shared Services for a Fortune 100 corporation, where he oversaw the employee benefit design and delivery for more than 225,000 active and retired employees. He is a former ERISA partner at Jenner & Block where he specialized in executive compensation, ERISA and M&A. Prior to Jenner & Block, Mr. Eickelberg spent nearly a decade as a consultant with William M. Mercer, Inc., a world-wide benefits consultancy.

He is a Fellow of the American College of Employee Benefits Counsel and serves on the College’s Executive Committee. He is a former Chairman of the American Benefits Council and served on the Board of Directors of the ERISA Industry Committee.
